As God has blessed us with a wonderful place, we need people who can appreciate God's wonderful creation and strive to use it to His honor and glory.

Camp Jabez is an outreach of the Gospel Mission, Inc. established in 1912 for the purpose of sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ.



The Equine Academy is designed to be a win-win situation for all concerned. This six month program allows for very affordable training at excellent facilities and at the same time assists the camp in keeping the horses in good shape for the next camp season.

EQUINE ACADEMY BENEFITS

There are so many benefits to this program that add up to a great value for a serious horse lover. We know of no place else where all of the following can be obtained for the price and accomplish all that it does.

Our equine academy includes everything you receive in the Adopt-A-Horse program plus:

- A bi-monthly "homework" hands on with your horse DVD series that will help you to visually "see" the goals you are striving to attain in your relationship with your horse.
- This is actually a "curriculum" of learning; there is a syllabus for the "course". The student will know the objectives for themselves and their horse.
- This program takes 7 months and at the end of the program you will have the option of being "tested" in your ability to achieve a levels system from a national natural horse program. This is an independent test and has an additional cost of \$70 for certification if you choose that option.
